Such acts, occurrences or elements of nature include, but are not limited to: 1) thunder and lightning; 2) wind and wind-driven objects; 3) rain; 4) water; 5) wild/domestic animals, insects and reptiles which may walk, run or fly near, or may bite or sting a horse or rider; 6) uneven or unstable footing on outdoor trails or raw land that is subject to changes to weather, temperature, water, and natural and man-made changes in the land-scape.
I.	SADDLE GIRTHS - NATURAL LOOSENING. I understand saddle girths (saddle fasteners around horse's belly) may loosen during a ride. If a rider notices such loosening, he/she must alert the nearest guide or wrangler as quickly as possible so action may be taken to avoid slippage of the saddle and a potential fall from the horse.
